The criteria by which the candidates will be evaluated are:

- 1. Academic potential
- 2. Benefit to Sons of Norway and to the larger Norwegian community
- 3. Statement of education and career goals
- 4. Involvement in school and community activities
- 5. Other (e.g., work experience)

To qualify, candidates must be **current** members of District Two - Sons of Norway **or** children or grandchildren of **current** members of District Two - Sons of Norway. The applicant must have met the entrance requirements (e.g., completion of at least one year of studies at the university level) and applied to attend the International Summer School at the University of Oslo (award contingent on acceptance). This scholarship will provide the winner with basic tuition, and room, and board in the university dormitory. The recipient will be expected to provide the balance of the funds needed for expenses of the six-week summer session including extra classes, optional trips, and other costs of the trip to Norway and return.
