5. Other (e.g., work experience)

To qualify, candidates must be **current** members of District Two - Sons of Norway **or** children or grandchildren of **current** members of District Two - Sons of Norway. The applicant must have met the entrance requirements (e.g., completion of at least one year of studies at the university level) and applied to attend the International Summer School at the University of Oslo (award contingent on acceptance). This scholarship will provide the winner with basic tuition, and room, and board in the university dormitory.
